To accurately grade whether your ASL students have appropriate skills and meet the course expectations can be a challenge. Weak measurement skills may result in having students with large differences in their production skills. This course will provide some tips on how to create rubrics for certain assignments or projects so that it becomes clear for ASL teachers how to measure certain skills and grammatical structure for each unit. After the course, participants will leave knowing the basic purpose of creating a rubric, grading percentages, and expectations from students.
